PHILIPPINE ENERGY LABELING PROGRAM (PELP) IMPLEMENTATION

INTRODUCTION

The enactment of Republic Act No. 11285, otherwise known as the Energy Efficiency & Conservation (EEC) Act, provides for the institutionalization of energy efficiency and conservation as a national way of life and paved the way for the establishment of a framework for introducing and institutionalizing policies on EEC, including the promotion of efficient and judicious utilization of energy across all sectors.

Chapter V of the said Act provides for the implementation of energy performance and labeling requirements, which includes the development of minimum energy performance (MEP) for products and enforcement of the mandatory energy labeling requirement for energy-consuming products (ECPs). These initiatives institutionalizes energy efficiency through regulation of energy-consuming products sold in the Philippine market, promote high efficiency in the manufacture and importation of ECPs, and empower consumers in choosing energy-efficient products at the point of sale. The regulation of ECPs is anticipated to significantly contribute to energy savings, reduction of energy consumption by using energy-efficient products, and reduction of GHG emissions.

As the lead agency mandated to enact programs on energy performance and labeling requirements, the DOE spearheaded the formulation and development of MEP for various ECPs, imposition of energy labeling requirements, creation and administration of the National Energy Efficiency and Conservation Database (NEECD), and enforcement of various EEC programs and initiatives.

For CY2025, following has been accomplished:

A. Policy Formulation

Pursuant to Department Circular No. DC2020-06-0015, or “Prescribing the Guidelines of the PELP”, the DOE drafted the technical requirements and developed the Code of Practice in Energy Labeling (COPE) as part of the Particular Product Requirements (PPR) of additional ECPs. These efforts covered the following product categories:

- Microwave Oven
- Electric Kettle
- Instantaneous Water Heater
- Electric Iron
- Cooking Fume Extractor

These Implementing Guidelines serve to standardize labeling and registration requirements, thereby strengthening compliance and consumer awareness. Furthermore, priority has been accorded to the development and issuance of the Provision on MEP Compliance Mechanism under the PELP IG for REMVCM for 2026.

B. Public/Stakeholders’ Consultation

In support of transparent and participatory policy formulation, the DOE conducted public and stakeholder consultations throughout CY2025. These consultations aimed to inform stakeholders of proposed policies, solicit feedback, identify implementation concerns, and promote collaborative engagement.

The consultations culminated in strengthened IGs for multiple ECPs and enhanced alignment between regulatory requirements and industry practices. In 2025, the DOE conducted three (3) public consultations and five (5) DOE Working Group and Technical Working Group (TWG) meetings.

During these activities, key provisions of the draft policies were presented, stakeholder concerns were addressed, and constructive recommendations were carefully considered. Below is the summary of Public/Stakeholders' Consultations in 2025:

C. PELP Registration

Under Department Circular No. DC2020-06-0015, otherwise known as the PELP Guidelines, all ECP manufacturers, importers, and distributors are enjoined to register their company and respective products under the PELP for the issuance of an energy label.

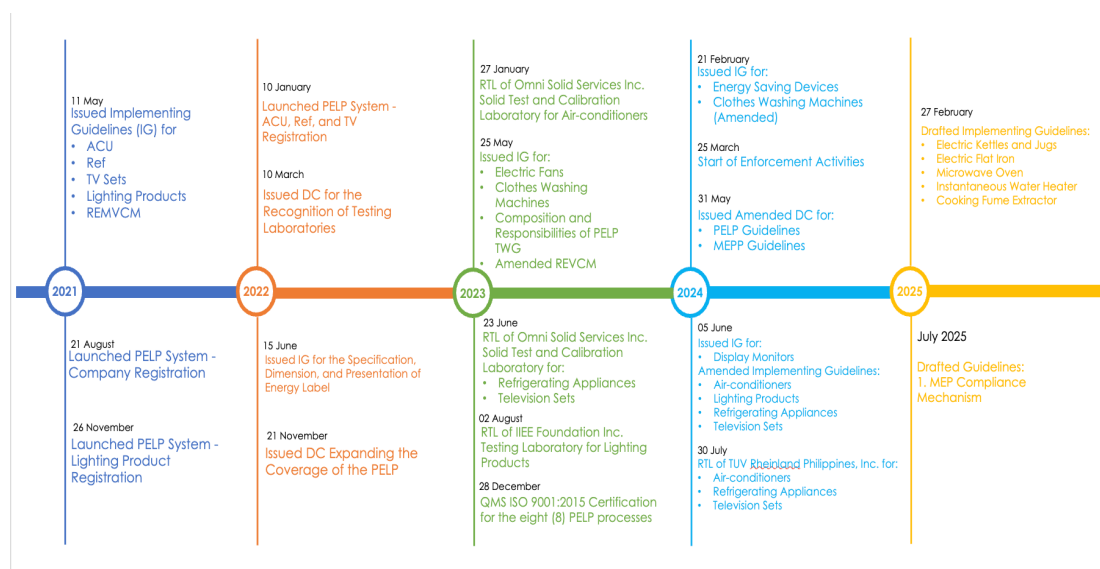
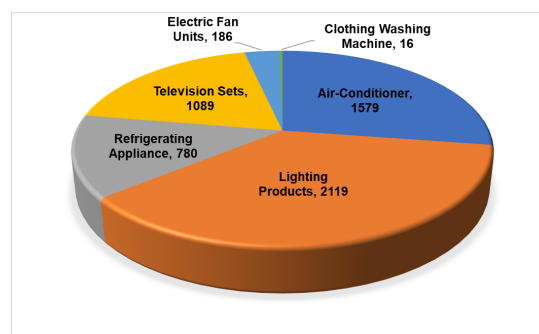


Figure 1. Summary of PELP Milestones

Since its launch on 12 August 2021, the DOE has approved 222 companies (see Annex A) engaged in the manufacturing, importation, and distribution of energy-consuming products in the Philippine market. In CY2025, the registration of products under the PELP continued, signaling the increasing recognition of the importance of energy labeling among manufacturers, importers, distributors, dealers, and retailers of ECPs. The registration process ensures that products in the market meet the energy performance standards set by the DOE.

In CY2025 alone, 1,801 new approved product models of air conditioners (362 models), lighting products (737 models), refrigerating appliances (133 models), television sets (325 models), electric fans (215 models), and clothes washing machines (29 models) were approved.



In the same period, the DOE issued 5,769 energy labels (Figure 2), comprised of labels for new product models and renewed labels for existing registered models. A total of 1,579 air conditioners models, 2,119 lighting products, 780 refrigerating appliance models, 1,089 TV sets, 186 electric fans, and 16 clothes washing machines models were issued with energy labels for 2025.

A cumulative total of **10,828 products models and 17, 893 issued energy label** in various categories, such as air conditioning units, refrigerators, lighting products, television sets, washing machines, and electric fans, have been successfully registered under the PELP.

With the continued expansion of the scope of PELP, the addition of registration and labeling of Energy Saving Devices and Display Monitors is anticipated in 2026. Correspondingly, enhancements to the PELP System are underway to support increased registration volume and the implementation of existing covered ECPs with higher capacities and MEPP.

D. Enforcement, Monitoring and Verification Activities

To ensure compliance with the prescribed requirements of the PELP, the DOE undertakes regular nationwide enforcement, monitoring and verification activities. These initiatives are integral to promoting energy efficiency, ensuring accurate information for consumers and maintain fair market practices. Through on-site inspections, the DOE Monitoring Team visits PELP-registered companies and ECP retail establishments to validate their information and confirm their adherence to the PELP Guidelines.

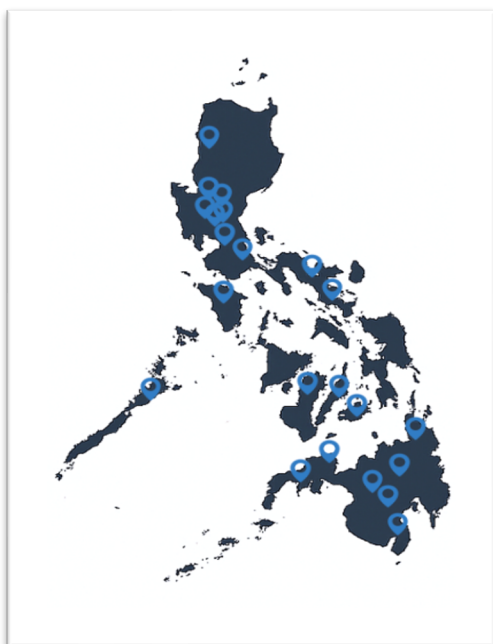


Figure 3. Nationwide PELP Monitoring and Enforcement activities

Since the commencement of enforcement activities in March 2024, the DOE has inspected a total of 144 ECP retail stores nationwide to verify the presence of the PELP energy label on ECP units on display, validate the accuracy of information in the label, and check its validity. Initial inspection results indicated a compliance rate of 72.2%, with various non-compliances observed during inspection. The concerned retail establishments were issued a Show Cause Order, directing them to implement necessary corrective actions within 10 working days to address identified non-compliances. Following the satisfactory implementation of the submitted corrective measures, the overall compliance rate increased to a hundred percent (100.0%).

In 2025, a total of 77 enforcement and monitoring activities have been conducted in retail establishments nationwide. Initial compliance has improved by 6%, from 77.7% in 2024 to 82.7% in 2025, which could be attributed to increase in awareness on PELP and guidelines for compliance. Aside from enforcement and monitoring activities in retail stores, the DOE also conducts verification activities in PELP-registered companies to assess compliance with PELP requirements and verify the accuracy of documentation submitted during registration. In 2025, a total of **32** PELP-registered companies have been visited by the DOE Monitoring Team (Table 5). The on-site visits aim to evaluate the accuracy and completeness of original documents submitted during the online registration process and ensure that the physical documentation are aligned with the digital records provided to the DOE.

For 2026, the DOE will continue the conduct of nationwide enforcement and monitoring activities, alongside the initiation of verification and sampling efforts, to ensure sustained compliance to PELP guidelines and uphold consumer protection.

E. Recognition of Testing Laboratories

As part of its continuing efforts to strengthen regulatory oversight and ensure the accuracy and credibility of claimed efficiency ratings of PELP-registered energy consuming products, the DOE grants recognition to qualified testing laboratories that meet established technical and quality standards. As established in Department Circular No. DC2022-03-0005, or "Guidelines for the Recognition of Testing Laboratories for the Examination, Testing, and Verification of the Energy Efficiency of ECPs and the Fuel Efficiency of Transport Vehicles, including the Issuance of Certificate of Endorsement to the Board of Investments for Fiscal Incentives", DOE-Recognized Testing Laboratories (DOE-RTLs), together with the DOE-Lighting and Appliance Testing Laboratory (DOE-LATL), play a crucial role in providing support for product testing during sampling and verification activities. Through this initiative, the DOE reinforces the reliability of data in the energy label, facilitates industry compliance, and upholds the integrity of energy efficiency policies.

Since 2023, the DOE has assessed and issued recognition to three (3) local testing laboratories with a total of nine (9) facilities capable of performing energy performance testing for the various types of ECPs covered by the PELP.

In addition, the DOE provided technical assistance to the said laboratories through the conduct of technical visits and evaluation of testing facilities of **SPIA Testing Laboratory** (for electric fan testing) and **TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc.** (for electric fan and clothes washing machine testing) laboratories. These activities were undertaken in the laboratories' actual test facilities energy performance testing protocols, and overall capacity and technical capabilities. The evaluations, carried out in accordance with applicable guidelines and standards, are intended to support the laboratories in preparing for the subsequent application for recognition of their electric fan and clothes washing machine test facilities.

In 2025, DOE conducted technical assessment of the lighting products test facility of **SPIA Testing Laboratory** and the air conditioner, refrigerator, and television set testing facilities of **TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc.**

Following the relocation of its laboratory, TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc. applied for the recognition of its air conditioner, refrigerator, and television set testing facilities and underwent technical assessment in November 2025. On 19 December 2025, the testing facilities for air conditioners and television sets were officially recognized as DOE-RTLs. On the other hand, recognition of the lighting products test facility of **SPIA Testing Laboratory** and refrigerator test facility of **TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc.** remains pending, subject upon the completion and approval of required documentation and implementation of identified corrective actions.

F. Information, Education and Communication Campaign

In support of the effective implementation of the PELP, the DOE carried out strategic Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) initiatives to strengthen stakeholder awareness and understanding of energy labeling requirements, compliance

mechanisms and benefits. These initiatives were designed to promote compliance, enhance consumer confidence in energy labels, and encourage informed purchasing decisions that contribute to national energy efficiency objectives. Through these focused engagement and dissemination efforts, the DOE advanced the visibility, credibility, and impact of the PELP nationwide.

Target participants to IEC activities include stakeholders from the industrial sector (i.e., manufacturers, importers, and distributors of energy-consuming products); commercial sector (i.e., representatives from appliance retail stores, dealership, and commercial outlets); members of the academe (i.e., academic institutions and engineering practitioners); as well as the consumer sector (i.e., residential household consumers and students).

A total of **five (5)** IEC activities were conducted in 2025, covering the overview of the PELP Guidelines, with particular emphasis on the scope and implementation updates; familiarization of the PELP Energy Label, equipping them with the knowledge to effectively identify and interpret energy efficiency information when purchasing energy-consuming products; and discussion on enforcement, monitoring and compliance mechanisms, ensuring their adherence to PELP guidelines. The IEC activities were attended by importers, manufacturers, and distributors of ECPs covered under PELP, appliance retail store representatives, testing laboratories, and DOE employees.

For 2026, continuous conduct of IEC activities will be done to actively engage stakeholders and consumers through diverse platforms, including seminars, workshop, meetings, and public consultations to disseminate PELP information and empower consumers in making informed choices.

G. Quality Management System Certification

The unwavering dedication of DOE towards exceptional service and fulfilling clients' needs has prompted the pursuit of certification for its services related to the implementation of PELP. These certifications signify DOE's commitment to quality, efficiency, and continual improvement, ensuring that each process goes beyond client satisfaction.

On October 10, 2025, a comprehensive assessment for its 1st surveillance audit conducted by SOCOTEC Certification Philippines, Inc., and was recommended for re-certification of its Quality Management System (QMS) in accordance with the requirements of ISO 9001:2015 – Quality Management Systems.
